 - a) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5.00 Lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs.3.00 Lakhs.
 - c) The institution has selected the Principal / Head and **Seven** teachers for the said course and the staff list is approved by Calicut University.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Sullamussalam College of Teacher Education, Areacode, Malappuram District, Pin - 673639, Kerala** for **Secondary course of one year duration** from the academic session **2004-2005** with an annual intake of **100** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a) The institution will ensure that **Eight** faculty members are in position for an intake of **100** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.
 - b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.

 5.  6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

PREAMBLE :

Sullamussalam Teacher Training Institute, Areacode P.O. Malappuram District, Pin - 673639, Kerala has made application for grant of recognition for Elementary course of two year duration to Southern Regional Committee on 31.12.2003.

On scrutiny of the application it was found that application was incomplete and essential documents as required under regulations were not submitted.

Accordingly, an offer letter with deficiencies was issued to the above institution for elementary course by SRC on 31.01.2003 stating the following deficiencies :-

- ❖ Land Title Certificate issued by a local practicing lawyer
- ❖ Copy of approved building plan should be approved by Municipal Corporation / Panchayath.
- ❖ Fixed Deposit receipt in original for Rs.5.00 lakhs towards Endowment Fund
- ❖ Sworn Affidavit verifying the contents given in the application form and the documents duly attested by a First Class Magistrate / SDM / ADM.
- ❖ A copy of English version of valid land documents duly attested by an Advocate.
- ❖ Legally valid land documents registered in the name of the Trust / Society.

In reply to the above letter, institution in its letter dated.13.03.2003 has submitted the above documents.

The institution was visited on 27.04.2004 to assess the infrastructural and instructional facilities. The visiting team report was placed before 76th meeting of SRC held on 24-25 June 2004 and decided to issue notice before rejecting the proposal for elementary course. Accordingly, Notice was served on 05.07.2004 by pointing out the following deficiencies:

- ❖ Science, Psychology and Educational Technology lab are not equipped as per NCTE norms.
- ❖ The institution has not identified adequate number of qualified teaching staff.

The written representation of the institution dated 19.07.2004 was placed before 77th meeting and SRC decided to reject the proposal as the institution had made compliance subsequent to the issue of notice. Rejection orders were served on 05.08.2004 with the following deficiencies.

- ❖ Science, Psychology and Educational Technology lab are not equipped as per NCTE norms.
- ❖ The institution has not identified adequate number of qualified teaching staff.

The applicant institution preferred appeal before NCTE, New Delhi against the rejection order issued by this office dated.05.08.2004. The Appellate Authority considered the appeal and passed order on 09.06.2005 remanded back to SRC-NCTE for re-considering the application for running Elementary course for the next academic session i.e. 2005-2006 by causing an early inspection to the institution.

Accordingly, inspection of the institution was carried out on 20.09.2005 and the report of inspection team and other documents furnished by the institution along with the application were considered by the Southern Regional Committee in its 100th meeting held on 23-24 September, 2005. The committee noticed that one of the essential documents as per Appendix – 1B of NCTE Regulations, 2002 i.e. FDR is dated 16.08.2005 and the application is deemed to be complete only after the submission of FDR. Hence the application is not eligible for being considered for the current academic year 2005-06 and is only eligible for being considered for the next academic year 2006-07.

However, SRC decided to grant recognition to the institution for the current academic year 2005-2006 due to the following reason:

In the earlier meetings, SRC decided to grant recognition for institutions which have submitted belated documents to be eligible for the year 2006-2007. However, some institutions who have been granted recognition for the subsequent year based on belated endorsements preferred an appeal to NCTE Hqrs and contended that a few institutions which have submitted belated endorsements were granted recognition for the current academic year. SRC, in its comments to the NCTE Hqrs explained that this has occurred due to oversight and would modify such orders, which have been wrongly issued. Pursuant to this, the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi, No.F.No.89-156/2005-Appeal dated 28th September, 2005 remanded back the cases to the SRC, Bangalore with a direction to reconsider the cases immediately for granting recognition from 2005-2006 on par with other similar cases who have been granted recognition for 2005-2006.

The same was placed before SRC in its 103rd meeting held on 27 - 28 October, 2005 and SRC after obtaining a considered legal opinion in this regard, decided to review its recognition orders issued for the session 2006-07 and to grant recognition for the session 2005-06 to those institutions who have submitted belated NOCs/Endorsements as one time exception. Subsequently, SRC in its 104th meeting held on 9-10 November 2005 has decided to extend this one time relaxation to other institutions who have submitted other documents mentioned in Appendix – 1B of the NCTE Regulations, 2002 belatedly, as one time exception.

Hence the following order

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ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Sullamussalam Teacher Training Institute, Areacode P.O. Malappuram District, Pin – 673639, Kerala** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting **Elementary course of two year duration** from the academic session **2004-2005** with an annual intake of **50** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5.00 Lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs.2.00 lakhs
- d) The institution has selected the Principal / Head and **five** teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Sullamussalam Teacher Training Institute, Areacode P.O. Malappuram District, Pin – 673639, Kerala** for **Elementary course of two year duration** from the academic session **2005-2006** with an annual intake of **50** students subject to fulfillment of the following.

- a) The institution will ensure that **six** exclusive faculty members (Principal/Head and five teachers) are in position for an intake of **50** students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions.
- b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
- d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC / University / State Government etc.,
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University for the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution namely **Sullamussalam College of Teacher Education, Areacode, Malappuram District, Pin-673639, Kerala** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F. KL/SEC/N/336/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/788 dt. 23.02.2005 for conducting Secondary **B.Ed.** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by a notarized affidavit dt. 15.07.2015 consented to come under new Regulations.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the Southern Regional Committee (NCTE) issued the Revised Provisional Recognition order dt.31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfilment of conditions mentioned therein.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, a corrigendum was issued vide order No. F.SRO/NCTE/aPSO1074/B.Ed/KL/2015/77261 dated 29.10.2015 for permitting the institution to have one basic unit of 50 students form the academic session 2015-2016.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 17.07.2019. The matter was further considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC as per its decision taken 380th meeting held from 18-19 September 2019. The sub-Committee of the SRC decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 31.10.2019. The institution submitted its reply on 29.11.2019.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 387th meeting held on 24th & 25th August 2020 and the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition**. Accordingly, The Withdrawal Order issued to the institution on 07.09.2020.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed W.P. (C) No.18457 In the High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam against withdrawal order dt. 07.09.2020. The Hon'ble High Court of Kerala passed an order dt. 25th September 2020.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 389th meeting held on 12th & 14th October 2020 & 391st meeting held on 03rd November,2020. Accordingly, Letter was issued on **09.11.2020**. The institution submitted its reply on 03.12.2020.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on 15th -16th December 2020 and the Committee decided as under: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Sullamussalam College of Teacher Education, Areacode, Malappuram District, Pin-673639, Kerala for B.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students.

10. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution continuation of conducting **Sullamussalam College of Teacher Education, Areacode, Malappuram District, Pin-673639, (Survey No.280/1,) Kerala** run by **Jam-lyyathul Mujahideen Areacode (PO) Malappuram (DT) Kerala-673939** for **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an intake of 50 students (one basic units of 50 student) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:**

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation form the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

11. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.

12. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

13. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
15. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
16. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a corrigendum was issued vide order No.F.SRO/NCTE/APS01074/B.Ed./KLJ/2015/77261 dated 29.10.2015 for permitting the institution to have one basic unit of **50 students** from the academic session 2015-2016.

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution on **18.11.2019**. The Committee observed and found the following deficiencies: -

1. The institution has not submitted LUC duly approved by the competent authority

2. The institution has submitted copy of building plan but not approved by the competent authority
3. The institution has submitted copy of site plan but not approved by the competent authority
4. Total built up area not mentioned in building Completion certificate.
5. The institution has not submitted certified copy of registered land.
6. Original Staff list approved by the Secretary of **Sullamssalam College of Teacher Education** consisting of one principal, Seven Assistant Professor & one part time Lecturer submitted.
 - (i) Percentage of marks in r/o Principal & assistant professor at (S.No.1 & 8) is less than 55%. Out of two, S.No. 1 & 8 are in OBC Category.
 - (ii) In the staff list, out of 9 faculty members, one is part-time lecturer: **Muhammed Sajeer B** (physical education)
 - (iii) The institution has submitted staff list but not approved by the affiliating body.
 - (iv) Principal doesn't have the qualification of NET/P.Hd.
 - (v) SI No. (4, 5 & 8) not qualified NET/P.Hd as per NCTE regulation 2017.
7. The institution has submitted copy of FDR Rs.5 lakh & 3 lakh total Rs.8 lakh against the requirement FDR Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh. The institution has not submitted Form A duly issued by the concerned Bank.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **S.N.D.P. Yogam Training College, Adimali, Ldukki District, Pin-685561, Kerala** for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Sullamussalam College of Teacher Education, Areacode, Malappuram District, Pin-673639, Kerala** for conducting B.Ed. course of two year duration **with an annual intake of 50 students w.e.f. the next academic session.**

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
